October 6, 2008, 6:30 pm

Meeting minutes will be sent to attending Board members for corrections. Corrected minutes will be e-mailed to Beatrice Williams to be sent to all MAG members either through e-mail accounts or paper copies sent with the monthly newsletter.

Art fair listing: After final contact nonpaying members will be removed from the list. The current list of names is scheduled through to 2012. Norma Hove proposed that no further name drawing occur until July 2009. Kathy Winters seconded the motion and it was passed.

June Salon: Kathryn Lederhause would like to step down as chair. It was also noted that Louise Joyce would like to step down as newsletter chair. Beatrice Williams will ask for volunteers and bring sign up sheets to the 10/8/08 new member fall dinner at Biaggi's.

Rental of display units: Equipment display panels for \$15/day or \$30/two days are available to MAG members. A list of available equipment, storage unit address, and rental contact information for Beatrice Williams will be in the October newsletter. There is also 5'x 5' section of MAG's storage space unit available for rent of \$22.50/month.

January show: Judy Peterson is in charge of the exhibition at the UW Hospital.

Hilldale show Oct 25 and Oct 26: Loretta Dooley is chair. Full booths cost \$175 and 5% of sales go to MAG.

Change Bylaw wording on member jurying: Article 1 Section 1. Application for membership

2. "The application and art works shall be reviewed by one or two jurors with a member of the Board. The Board member would be used only in case of a tie." should be changed to "The application and art works shall be reviewed by an outside professional artist and the decision will be final."

3. "When the applicant is accepted by the juror(s),"...should be changed to "When the applicant is accepted by the juror,"

Article VII Section 1. Amount of dues

1. "Members shall pay annual dues of \$20.00." should be changed to "Members shall pay annual dues of \$25.00."
