7/6/09 MAG meeting minutes

Present: Loretta Dooley, Beatrice Williams, Norma Hove, Kathy Winters, Merikay Payne Chicago trip: Kerri Shannon, organizer, was absent. No date has been set. MAG will have an invitation in the Wisconsin Painters and Sculptors newsletter. Merikay Payne will send a request to invite UW art undergrads and 14 South Artists members.

By-laws: Due to time constraints there was no vote on the by-laws at the June Salon member meeting. Beatrice Williams will call Sally Probasco to see if the Fall Dinner would be an acceptable time to put the bylaw vote before the members. Lori Haack will be organizing the Fall Dinner. No date has been set. Salon reception: Beatrice Williams will thank Kathryn Lederhause for her work and ask her to attend the Salon review of procedures. The executive committee will meet for a half hour before the August 3 meeting

to review the costs and process for the 2010 Salon. Norma Hove will bring her Salon packet to the August 3 meeting for reference.

Newsletter ads: There will be an ad for Lynn's in the newsletter.

Letters to gift suppliers. Beatrice Williams will send thank you letters to Salon contributors and ask if they would like to have a complementary ad in the newsletter. If they are interested, a scan of their business card could be used.

Art Fair: Kathy Winters said 4 people out of 6 have responded to her about the Art Fair. All six have paid their share of the area. By July 20 each artist in the Art Fair should pay Norma the MAG 5% commission on what they sold.

Treasurer's report: The Salon cost \$2369, not including publication of the Salon booklet. In order to save money next year the awards will be printed double sided rather than the booklet. The Salon had 122 participate out of 143 members. Norma will give the list of absent members to Cindy Koshalek, member coordinator, to contact. There were 26 awards. Income from the Salon was 122 members/\$10 fee. Expenses were \$300 judge, \$1040 awards (includes \$150 donations and \$100 from WPS), \$640 reception, \$133 ribbons and a fee for mailing the packets.
