Membership Reminder

Since your MAG Salon Registration and Membership Renewal packet was mailed to you back in March, a reminder might be in order. Your registration for the Summer Salon is due by May 24. The registration form is to be sent to David Carpenter, who is recording the information for the Salon Committee. Your membership renewal and \$45.00 dues payment is due by June 30. Membership renewal and dues check are to be sent to the MAG Post Office Box. While many of you have already registered for the Salon, and many have renewed your membership, many of you have not. There is still plenty of time to respond. What if you bring your art to the Salon drop-off without registering? Your work will be accepted, but you will be asked to complete a registration form at drop-off, and there will not be any identification label to attach to your work. What if you fail to renew your membership and pay your annual dues? You will receive one reminder notice and if you then do not respond, you will be dropped from the MAG membership. We value our members and encourage your participation in our shows. We look forward to hearing from you. Thanks.

This note requests your annual dues payment and any updates needed in your information shown in the MAG Directory. It also contains the registration form for Madison Art Guild's Summer Salon at U.W. Hospital.

Please complete the lower portion of this sheet and mail it along with your check for \$45.00, made out to Madison Art Guild. <u>Dues payment is due by June 30, 2015</u>. Failure to pay dues will result in removal from MAG. The payment amount is the same as last year, but is no longer divided between dues and a Salon fee. The payment amount is the same for Active and Inactive members. Honorary Members are exempt from all MAG dues. MAG has also dropped the previous 5% commission on sales occurring in the Salon, but U.W. Hospital charges a 20% commission on all sales.

The Summer <u>Salon Registration form is to be mailed separately, by May 24, 2015.</u> There is no fee for the Salon, and it is no longer a requirement of MAG membership. However, participation in at least one MAG event annually is required to maintain active membership. New categories of art have been identified for the 2015 Salon, and there are cash awards for winners in each category.
