Heritage Credit Union in Prairie du Sac is a unique office setting that boasts a café, library area, and gallery space that allows for artists to display installments for public viewing. I am currently looking for artists to display their work for the following dates in the upcoming year. These are the available installment dates:

January 4, 2016 thru February 26, 2016 February 29, 2016 thru April 29, 2016 May 2, 2016 thru July 15, 2016 July 18, 2016 thru August 30, 2016

The display spaces are each individually lit for optimal viewing, and we use a Walker-type cable hanging system. There is space for 6 larger pieces, or the ability for multiple smaller pieces to share wall space as well. Upon request, elevations of each wall space will be provided, as well as time to come personally visit the branch to get a feel for the space. Art on display can be for sale, but all transactions are handled between the prospective buyer and the artist. Heritage Credit Union does not collect any commission on pieces sold.

## **Wine and Art Teaching Opportunity**

Laurie Struss, of the Cambridge Arts Council, is looking for artists that might be interested in teaching a wine and art class. All classes are on Friday Nights at the Camrock Café 7:00 to 9:00pm.

The art project needs to be able to be completed within the two hour time frame.

Each class costs \$35 per student, with \$10 of that fee going to the Camrock for the drinks, and \$25 going to the instructor. This must cover their supplies and time (generally about \$500-\$600).
