Make Art Together

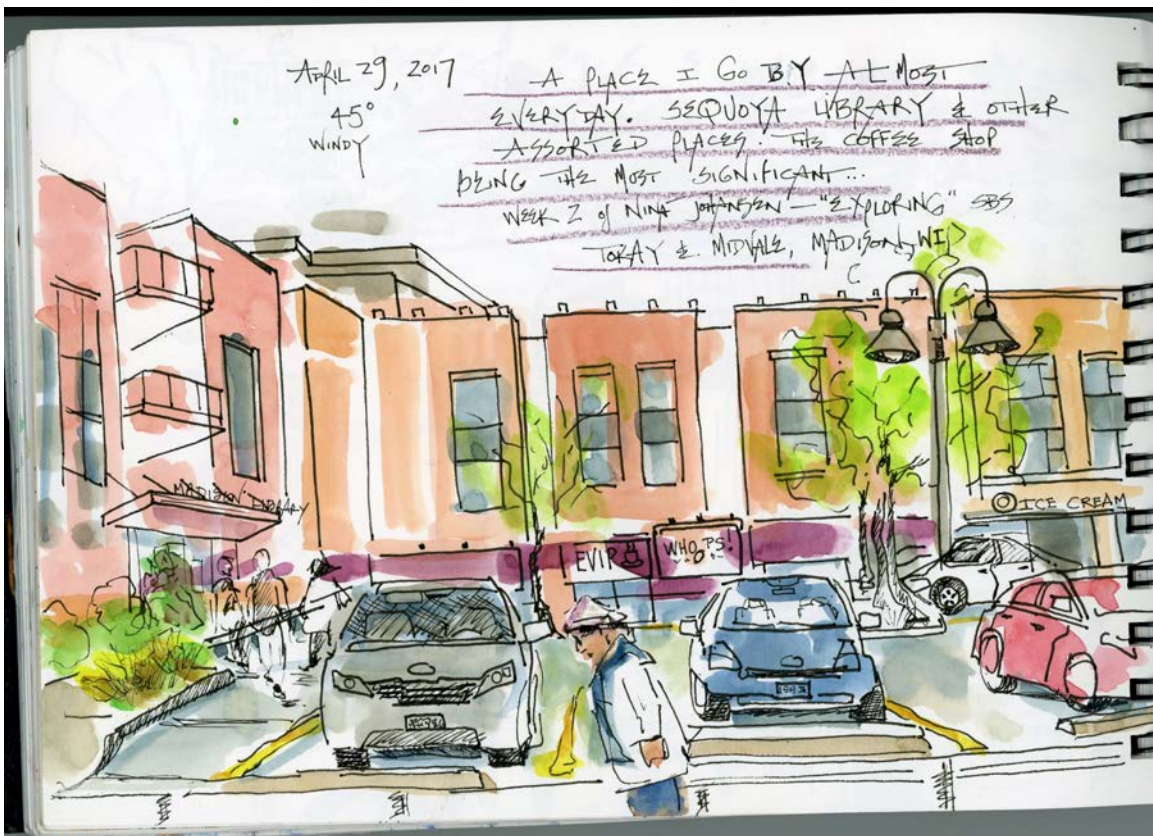
Get ready artists! In the spirit of MAG's successful Art Nights, we are launching a new initiative called Make Art Together starting Fall 2017.

Board Meeting Minutes from May 9, 2017
6:00 PM at Fitchburg Public Library

Presidents' Reports

Sherry - AFOS

Presented revisions to procedure for selecting participants for Art Fair on the Square (AFOS)

1. Anyone who shows at AFOS will not be eligible to show again for the three years following
2. If someone drops out prior to May 15th, half of the paid fee will be refunded (after this date, there will be no refund)
3. There will be three alternates. If an alternate participates, (s)he would pay the half of the fee that was refunded.
4. Alternates who do not choose to participate will remain eligible to participate the following year(s)
5. The people who will be showing this year (plus two alternates) have been notified

Chris

1. **Tent set-up practice** - Sunday, May 28th at 11:00 AM (Tom Kuchenbecker and Steve Ralser will supervise) (Info about the location is in the April newsletter)
2. MAG expects to be in the same spot as last year at AFOS (not yet confirmed)

Open Positions

1. Vice President – ongoing discussion regard term and responsibilities
2. A binder is being compiled that will contain MAG Board policies, officers' terms and roles, and MAG procedures

Treasurer's Report (Tom)

1. Current balances
2. Payments:
3. Dine-Out fundraiser:
 - a. Karen Watson-Newlin has been mentioned as a possible chair for this event.

- b. Some ideas were mentioned regarding potential recipients of the money earned : possibly organizations and/or individual Fine Art Scholarship. Discussion will continue.
 - c. The Dine Out event will probably take place next year.
4. Board approved a one-time reimbursement of \$55 to Sherry for Costco membership for purchases made for the Summer Salon reception

Discussions:

1. Timelines for Membership, Events and Dues Payments:
There are a couple of proposals to be considered and discussed to revise current timeline to better accommodate new membership and avoid the collection of prorated dues.
Proposal(s) for new timelines will be sent to Board members prior to the July meeting so they can be discussed
2. New member jurying:
Suggestion made to change this procedure and have a committee of MAG members jury submissions instead of hiring one person to do it. Discussion will continue.
3. It was determined that MAG membership be restricted to residents of Dane County (i.e., members must have a Dane county address). This will go into effect next year.
4. We are going to try to provide an online process for a) members to provide updated info each year when paying dues and b) for new members to apply for MAG membership. Nancy Donahue will work on this as specific requests and needs are provided.

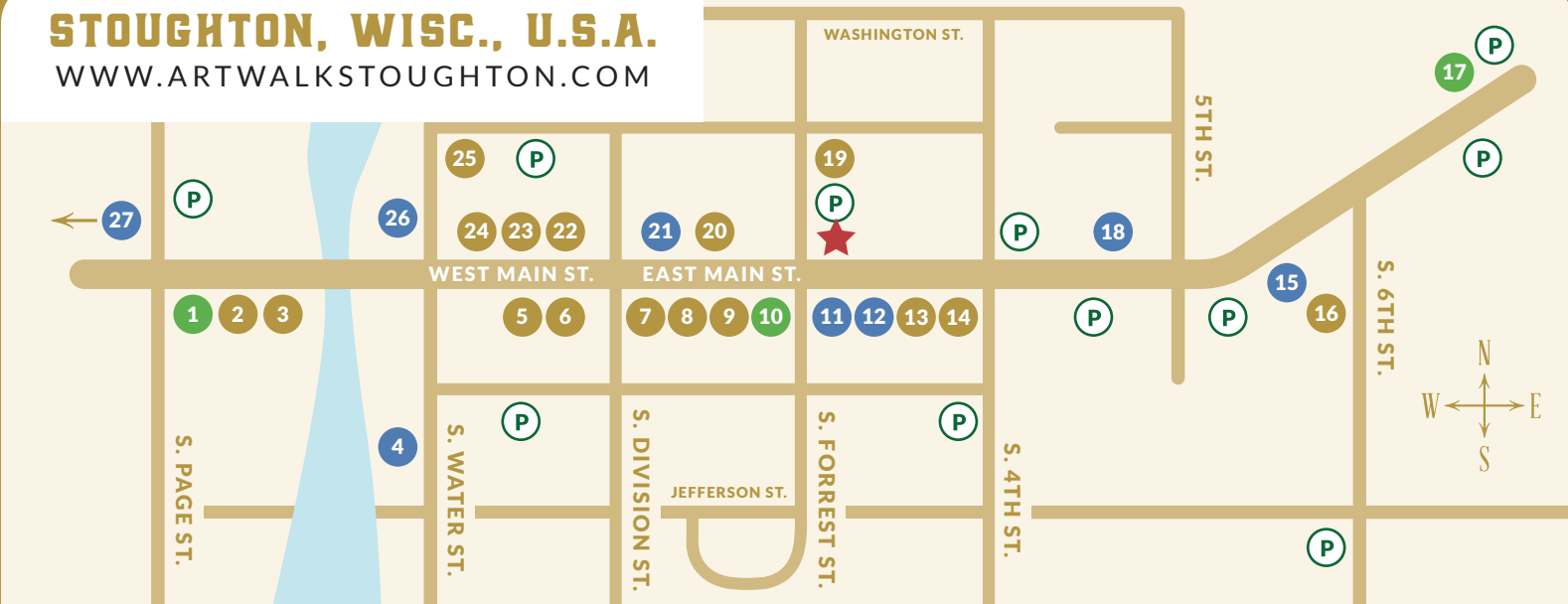
