MAG Bi-Monthly Meeting Minutes

July 10, 2018

- 1. Treasurer's Report Tom, Treasurer
 - As of July 1, 2018 MAG has \$10,765.62
 - Salon total costs were approx. \$400\
- 2. Salon Update Colette Girard, Event Coordinator
 - Reception was well-attended (only five award winners were not present)
 - Concerns and needs re: the judging were discussed
 - Judging criteria should be discussed/determined ahead of time
 - Categories entries ranged from only 4 to 22 entrants this will be discussed further at the September meeting
 - People who use US postal service should receive separate registration letter with instructions specifically for them
 - Winner of Pray award wants to contact family to thank them. This is encouraged and Nancy will find info and send it to Colette
 - Pick up
 - o Colette will send reminder and take home any work that isn't picked up
 - Extra programs will be available at pick-up table
 - At the time of the meeting, seven pieces had been sold
- 3. Art Fair on the Square
 - Theresa said that the run-through for setting up the display went smoothly
- 4. MAG Membership Theresa and Chris
 - Boundaries are given in the bylaws which need updating on the website
 - If an artist is in the greater Madison area and able to fulfill membership requirements (e.g., to participate in a salon) and be an active participant in other ways (s)he is eligible for membership
 - Participation requirements need to be clearly communicated to new members (by mentors and/or at the annual "dinner meeting"). Chris will write a newsletter article to inform and remind current members.
 - Membership Dates
 - September 8 Judging (Jury fee is \$15 for candidates)
 - September15 Dues need to be paid (Dues are \$45)
 - Tom K. offered to look for potential members at Art Fair Off the Square.
