Type the information below (without the words) in this order so it can be cut and pasted. If your piece is not for sale state NFS and provide a value. The value is used by the Hospital for insurance purposes.

### **Drop-off, Pick-up and Volunteers**

Two-dimensional work must have a hanging wire attached to the frame. Saw tooth brackets will not be accepted because they do not work with the hanging system.

Attach a label with artist name and title to the back of 2D work or the bottom of 3D work.

This is a nice show although sales weren't as good as expected. Other vendors around us also said the same about sales. It is very well organized for unloading and getting the materials to your space with no waiting to get to the dock, carts available to load stuff on, and volunteers showing where your space is located - overall a



much easier process than AFOTS. Traffic was very good on Saturday but not nearly as many buyers as expected. Sunday was much less traffic. MAG should definitely do this show on an annual basis. Visitors were enthused about seeing our work when it was explained in front of the entrance that "This is the MAG exhibit with five local artists each having an individual space inside". This show helps promote MAG tremendously in the community as does AFOTS when done properly and professionally.

### **MAG Bi-Monthly Meeting Minutes**

### Treasurer's Report - Tom

Dues were collected from 114 members. 17 members dropped out and 9 new members were inducted. Total membership, including 9 honorary members, is 123. MAG's balance of funds for November is \$15,720.40



(which includes \$5030 in a CD). Our yearly expenses are estimated to be \$3000. MAG's expenses for the Fall Banquet totaled \$1208. Members paid a combined total of \$736 for the dinner.

### President's Report - Chris

The MAG Banquet was deemed a success with a much better turnout than the previous year. Almost 50 people attended. Options for changing the menu and member cost for next year were discussed. It was decided that any increased cost for attendance would be minimal. Further planning was shelved until a later date.

Chris suggested contacting non-renewing members via a formal letter to ask for feedback about MAG as well as their reasons for not renewing.

We still need 5 additional volunteers to mentor new members. Thus far, Ruth Manning, Theresa Drinka and Terry Doeler have agreed to act as mentors. The position of Vice President remains open. A listing of all open positions with a description of duties will be posted to the membership by Chris.

### Membership Report - Theresa

Theresa reported that our new members are a diverse and supportive group. Several have already expressed their willingness to assist with technical support and workshop leadership.

There was discussion about combining some duties of the Membership Chair with the Directory Chair. It was decided that one person should be responsible for maintaining and updating membership/directory lists. That position will be titled "Directory Chair". Theresa will continue to oversee new membership recruitment and jurying. The finalized version of the 2019 directory will be distributed soon.

### January Showcase – Barbara

Barbara Vater has agreed to chair the January Showcase. Registration will be handled via email. Barbara has prepared a letter with detailed instructions that will be sent out very soon. It was discussed and decided that late registrations would not be accepted. And, because hospital staff prepares title cards prior to drop off/installation, no changes to artwork title, size or price will be allowed after the registration form has been submitted.

### MMoCA – Chris (for Terry)

Terry has assured Chris that everything is in place. Steve Ralser volunteered to help Terry with set-up.

The next board meeting will be on January 8, location to be determined (probably at Sequoia Public Library)
