While recognizing the impact of COVID-19, the board decided at the July meeting to keep the amount at \$45 and use much of the total to upgrade our outdated website and technical capabilities. The website upgrades needed are beyond the technical abilities of the membership. The website needs professional assistance to enable information updates, artists profile pages and contact links, and the ability to coordinate jury fees/membership dues through an online system. MAG will also aim to provide more exhibit and sales opportunities for MAG members via the internet since in person exhibits may continue to be restricted. Therefore, the board will be investing in a professional service in the upcoming months for the website restructure and a platform for the future. The plan is to develop a website that is easier for the MAG volunteer webmaster to navigate, make changes, and provide updates.

# **Bi-Monthly Meeting Minutes**

MAG Minutes, Zoom Meeting at 6:30 on July 14, 2020

<u>In attendance</u>: Chris Echtner, Karen Watson-Newlin, Dave Williams, Tom Kuchenbecker, Cindy Koshalek, Theresa Drinka, Martha Fitzmier, Terry Sullivan and Colette Girard.

Welcome - Chris and Karen

#### Treasurer's Report - Tom

Tom reported that as of July 1<sup>st</sup>, MAG's funds were as follows:

\$6,403.09 in checking plus \$5, 038.47 in CD for a total of \$11,441.56.

Tom paid our 2020 Charitable Organization's license fee of \$54 and paid out \$88.33 to Charmaine Harbort for printing and mailing newsletters to members without email. Due to cancellation of this year's physical salon, MAG has approximately \$857 more in funds available than at this time last year.

#### Dues - Tom

MAG's notice for renewal of membership dues will go out on August 1st.

Since the ongoing pandemic has curtailed MAG's artistic opportunities, Tom proposed reducing the \$45 membership fee as a good will gesture. There was discussion regarding the pros and cons of doing so. It was suggested that reducing fees this year could lead to confusion next year and it was noted that other professional associations have not reduced their dues. The point was also made that if dues were kept the same, MAG could put that money toward the badly needed upgrade of our website. There have been problems with members gaining access to post artwork. After a vote was taken, it was decided that MAG's membership dues would



remain the same. Discussion followed about hiring someone to build a new website and how much that might cost. It was suggested that we look to MATC for a possible webmaster.

#### Virtual Summer Salon - Colette, Chris and husband Jeff

A total of 62 members registered for the salon in six category groupings. The registration process went smoothly for most. A notice with instructions for voting went out yesterday and several votes have already been submitted.

It was suggested that MAG do more virtual shows with artwork for sale.

Mary Palmer is working to get the exhibit onto Facebook.

#### Art Fair On The Square - Terry

Terry reported that the virtual AFOS was well organized and noted that all MAG members scheduled for this year did participate. The Guild as a group was allowed a "Tile" for each member, and some did sell artwork. Terry suggested using the MMoCA model for our upcoming virtual shows. He also reported that the MMoCA Winter Show has a 10'x20' booth reserved for MAG.

Discussion bounced back to the update of our current website and the problems members have had gaining access to post artwork. Mention was made of the WVA website which allows each member a page of 5 -6 images with updates of artwork once a year.

#### New Member Jurying - Martha and Theresa

Martha reported that MAG's new member jurying is scheduled for Sept 12<sup>th</sup> in a small room reserved at the Fitchburg Library. There was discussion about social distancing and the possibility of assigned pick up and drop off times. Martha was doubtful that physical jurying would even be allowed due to the unpredictability of ongoing Covid 19 restrictions. She proposed the option of a virtual jurying, with each prospective member providing four images.

Martha will check to see if our judge, Leslee Nelson, is accepting of that option.

### Art Night Via Zoom - Chris and Karen

Zoom art nights seem to be going well.

The next bi-monthly meeting will be via zoom at 6:30, on September 8, 2020
