## **Website Changes Meeting**

SPECIAL MEETING OF THE MAG BOARD July 28, 2020 at 7pm, Via Zoom

<u>In Attendance</u>: Chris Echtner, Karen Watson-Newlin, Dave Williams, Tom Kuchenbecker, Andrea Murray, Colette Girard

Purpose: To discuss plans for a new MAG website

<u>Discussion</u>: We need a more current website. It should include a home page, an updated mission statement, a randomly rotating slide show of member's images, a listing of social art events. It was suggested than we take ideas from the WVA website and the CAVA website. We would have an instant link to our current exhibit right on the first page as well as tabs across the top with drop down menus. We could offer links to member's art videos or to you tube videos as well as links to social media and facebook. We might also highlight a "featured artist".

<u>Cost</u>: We don't want to deplete too much of our existing funds, but we do want to hire a qualified individual to build our website. It was suggested that we reach out to MAG members to ask if anyone does, or knows someone who does, website development. Karen offered the name of a possible developer who comes highly recommended and agreed to contact him. We need to figure out the maximum we are willing to spend prior to requesting quotes from potential developers. A MAG volunteer could be tapped to maintain the site once it is in place. Our current hosting site was compared to other possible hosting sites. We will ask the person we hire which host they prefer.

Website details: There will be an events page covering activities going on throughout the year (AFOS, MMoCA, Salon, Showcase). Each MAG member will have one page with 4 to 5 images, plus a statement paragraph with a limited number of characters. This page would be updated 2x yearly by the webmaster if artists wish to submit new images and information. Opinions differed regarding access to each artist's page. Should we have thumbnail images on the front page or just the artist's name and media? There should be a special link for MAG's by-laws. Do we need a private, members only area for the by-laws and board minutes? Requiring a log in might add complexity that we don't need.

<u>Plan</u>: Create a small committee to make decisions regarding today's discussion. This group will then present their findings to the board.
