


New Website

This is a page that will be visible to everyone who visits so the sooner you can supply this information the better.

- 1. Artist's Statement (300 words max)
- 2. Up to 6 images or your work in .jpg or .png format, ideally around 300 px wide.
- 3. (optional) URLs for your website, Facebook and/or Instagram pages.

PLEASE NOTE: Once you start entering your profile information you will NOT be able to save it and go back to it, so get everything together in one place on your computer!

- 1. To get started, first set your password.
 - Start the password reset process by clicking here. Enter your username (See above!) or registered email address.
 - Check your email inbox for a message from Wordpress@madisonartguild.com & click on the link to reset your password. If you don't receive an email be sure to check your SPAM or JUNK folder.
 - Create a new password, at least 8 characters long. Include a combination of UPPERCASE, lowercase, special character(s) and number(s). Be sure to remember your password (or store it in a safe place)!
- 2. Next visit the Member Portal to login.
 - Click on **SUBMIT YOUR INFO**. Our webmaster will be building your profile from the information you enter here.





- o Type in or copy/paste your artist's statement and other information.
- o Upload your images where indicated
- o Click the Captcha box and submit.

It will take a few weeks for the webmaster to complete all the profiles. Keep checking back to see the list of MAG Members grow!

Maximum image size is 5 MB. (Some tools to resize images are http://www.reduceimages.com/ or http://picresize.com.)

All images should be displayed on a neutral backdrop to ensure that all art is professionally presented.



By submitting your piece to the exhibit, you are agreeing that at least 20% of your sale price will be donated to the Food for Thought program.

The following information will be visible to exhibit visitors: Artist contact, Size, Medium, Price, Percentage of sale to be donated, Narrative

You will get a confirmation email if successful.

If you were unable to upload your image, email it to web@madisonartguild.com, with the subject = Your Artwork Title.
