Email the following information to web@madisonartguild.com:

Name, media, brief artist statement (maximum 200 words). Attach an image that will accompany your name on the main artist page (https://www.madisonartguild.com/artists). Optionally indicate your email, website, Facebook page and Instagram page. Attach up to six images of your artwork that will appear on your artist page.

Our webmaster will be building your profile from the information you send. It may take a few days for the webmaster to complete your profiles.

We now have a Madison Art Guild Facebook group page ("Madison Art Guild"). This is going to replace our current Facebook page. After joining the group, you can post directly. This page is visible to the public.

Posting guidelines are:

- posts must align with Madison Art Guild mission and purpose
- limit posts of personal artwork to once per week, not including posts about art shows / events (thus a member may post more than once if posts are artwork and event)
- no posts or comments about politics or religion, unless incorporated in artwork, subject to final guideline below
- refrain from personal posts (i.e. pictures of cat, leisure activities, etc.) unless those photos are the artwork itself
- keep comments positive or neutral at most
- MAG FB group administrator (Kristin) and MAG leadership reserve the right in their sole discretion to remove any post or comment that does not align with MAG mission and purpose, and / or that violates the above quidelines

To find the Facebook group page, you must use group search. Enter Madison Art Guild in Facebook Search and then click on the group filter. Once you get to the Facebook group, click Join Group.



Note that MAG FB group administrator (Kristin) will also be posting on the MAG group page about official MAG events. There will be periodic MAG member profiles also featured in our Facebook group. No administrator posts will be made without your permission.
