January Showcase

The Annual January Showcase to be displayed at UW Hospital is coming up. January 8 is the drop-off date and February 5 is the pickup. Entries must be sent by December 15.

Each MAG artist can have up to two artworks <u>if space allows</u>. If UW cannot accommodate two pieces from each submitting artist, preference for the second artwork will be determined by date and time of entry. You will be informed before drop-off which artwork to bring.

Entry email must include

- 1. Your Name
- 2. Title of artwork
- 3. Size of artwork
- 4. Price of artwork or NFS
- 5. 2D or 3D
- 6. Hanging or countertop

If entering two artworks, the first one listed will be considered your preference.

Entries should be sent to janshowcase@madisonartguild.com by December 15.

We are expecting that the drop off and pickup will be done by participating artists at the children's hospital entrance to UW Hospital.

MAG By-Laws

Occasionally we will highlight a portion of the MAG Constitution By-Laws. The complete By laws are posted in the member area of the MAG website.

ARTICLE II - OFFICERS

Section A. Selection of Officers

1. Elected Officers

The elected officers of MAG shall be: President, Vice-president, Secretary, and Treasurer. The nominating committee shall be responsible for the slate of candidates for elected office. Officers shall be elected at the annual meeting or a special meeting.

2. Terms

Each officer elected shall serve a term of two years. The Vice-president succeeds the President at the end of her/his term. At the end of the President's term s/he shall become Past President and shall serve a two-year term as a member of the Executive Committee. Officers and the past President may serve for consecutive terms if they are re-elected.

3. Resignations and Vacancies



If an officer is unable or unwilling to complete her/his term, the Executive Committee shall appoint a replacement.
