Currently the application process is open early August through early September, with juror decisions and notifications in late September. This means that the bulk of work is done July-September in about 2-4 hours per week during that time. The rest of the year is simply responding to email inquiries as they come in, plus time spent in the early summer to find and secure a juror.
