Board Meeting Minutes

May 14, 2024

At 6:31pm, President Linda Krantz called the meeting to order.

Twenty-three members signed in to tonight's zoom meeting which had been announced as an opportunity to vote on our new bylaws.

Board members in attendance: Linda Krantz, Owen Gwynne, Marcia Nelson, Kim Eitland, Mary McCormick Wixson, Mary Reines, Dave Williams, Karen Faller, Colette Girard.

Linda K asked for any corrections or comments re: minutes from the March meeting – there were none. Mary R moved to approve the minutes: Theresa Drinka seconded.

New Bylaws

21 out of 22 members cast anonymous votes via zoom. The results were 21 yes votes and zero no votes. The new bylaws passed. The 23rd member joined zoom after the vote was completed and did not cast a vote.

Artful Gathering Survey Results

Linda K shared results from the artful gatherings survey. She was pleased that 25% of the membership responded to the survey. The most requested topic was learning about the "business" of art, such as how to apply to exhibits, how to price artwork, etc. She added that she and Theresa Drinka recently attended a talk at



the UW Art Loft where pricing artwork was a big topic. Linda asked for the names of individuals who might be willing to lead a presentation.

Suggested presenters: Member "GG" for her knowledge of self-branding and promotion; Ben Orozco with the Art Lit Lab; Theresa Able of the Able Contemporary Gallery, Mandy Kron, art buyer for the UW Hospital and fiber artist Char TerBeest Kudla.

Treasurer's Report

Mary R explained that our restricted cash amount of \$3664.42 is used primarily for salon expenses. We also have an unrestricted cash amount of \$6567.06. Mary said that it's not too early to begin thinking about what we want to plan for in 2025. Membership dues are renewed in September, and we will have to decide if the amount remains the same or needs to be raised. Mary is currently working on MAG taxes.

Salon Report

Marcia N reported that, as of today, 59 members have registered. Typically, the bulk of registrations come in at the last minute. She plans to do an analysis this year re: what art tends to sell and at what price. Several members have offered to volunteer at drop off and pick up. Drop off is Sat, June 1st, from 9-10:30am, at the UW Health American Family Children's Hospital entrance.

Mary M provided an update as well. This year's Salon judge is Roberta Condon, an experienced gallery owner. Judging will take place on Sunday morning, June 2nd. Both Mary and Theresa Drinka will be on hand to assist. The reception will be held at the Goodman Community Center

on June 13th at 6pm. Volunteers will arrive at 5pm. Linda K will act as MC, and Kim E will photograph the exhibit and create a video. The ribbons have already been delivered.

Kim E reminded us that artwork content must be appropriate for the hospital surgical waiting area.

Old Business:

Paoli Art Fair

The submission deadline for the Paoli Art Fair is May 15th. MAG is eligible to enter as a group using our double tent, but no one has committed to act as chair. Mary M would step up as a co-chair, and Linda Farrelly and Kim E also expressed interest. The bonus associated with this event is that members in the MAG booth would not have to jury in.

Monona Public Space Update

Unfortunately, the individual who initially offered the use of free public space for a variety of art organizations has not responded to Linda's attempts to connect.

MAG will once again hold a two-month art exhibit at the Firefly in Oregon. The exhibit will run through July and August. Depending on the number of applicants, each artist will have approximately seven feet of wall space. Drop off date for this show will be July 1st at 11am. Applications will go out shortly.

We hope to hold another MAG picnic sometime in August. Last year's event went well and also served as an art night. A chair is needed for the picnic.
