

## **Member Dues Survey**

Results of the MAG Member dues survey are in. With 130 members voting, 40% support a \$5.00 increase, 35.4% support a \$10.00 increase, and 24.6% were opposed to an increase. This means that starting in September, 2024, annual Artist member dues will increase to \$50.00.

The reason for the two-color breakdown of results is because the survey had initially been sent with an incorrect dues amount, but results were being tabulated. When the survey was corrected and resent, Google tabulated additional results using different colors.



### **Possible Arboretum Show**

MAG is applying to the Steinhauer Trust Art Gallery at the UW Madison Arboretum for a show in 2025. Jennifer Angelo and Kerry Ervin have volunteered to be co-chairs if MAG's proposal is accepted.

The focus of our application and possible show is taken from the gallery information:

The purpose of the Gallery is twofold: to celebrate through the visual arts Wisconsin's natural heritage and the human connection to the land, and to showcase the creativity and talent of artists who draw their inspiration from nature.



The selection committee seeks work that complements the Arboretum's mission and purpose, such as subject matter focused on plants, animals, and landscapes native to Wisconsin and/or the Midwest, and that considers the relationship between humans and the land.

The application must include 6-8 samples of wall-hung art. If you have a piece that fits into the description above, please submit a pdf image of it by August 10 to Jennifer Angelo at <a href="mailto:jangelo@jangelo.com">jangelo.com</a> for possible inclusion in our application. These pieces don't necessarily need to be what you might ultimately hang in the show, but represent the talent of our members in consideration of the Gallery's purpose. One submission per member, please.

## **July Meeting Minutes**

Madison Art Guild Board Meeting Minutes July 9, 2024

The meeting was called to order by President, Linda Krantz, at 6:31pm.

In Attendance: Linda Krantz, Cindy Koshalek, Colette Girard, Jennifer Angelo, Ann Kleckner, Theresa Drinka, Barbara Koykkar, Tom Kuchenbecker, Ken Halfmann, Jane Foos, G.G.

Linda called for approval of the May, 2024 MAG minutes. Jennifer moved to approve, and Ann seconded. Dues Survey

Linda reported on the survey which was recently presented to the membership regarding a possible increase in dues. Thus far, 120 members have responded as follows: 23.4% were opposed to an increase; 35.9% were in favor of a \$10 increase; 40.6% were in favor of a \$5 increase.

### Treasurer's Report

Linda reported (for Mary Reines) that, as of July 1st, we have \$3299.42 in restricted funds (used for Salon awards) and \$4729.85 in unrestricted operating cash, for a total of \$8029.27. It was noted that our financial situation at this point, compared to last year at this time, shows \$450 more in our account. With dues being collected in September, it's time to plan for 2025 expenses.

### **Art Exhibitions**

MAG has the opportunity to participate in a new exhibition venue. The Steinhauer Trust Art Gallery at the Arboretum Visitor Center offers 90 linear feet of exhibit space in a beautiful setting. Exhibits are on view for two months, beginning in January of each year and must be nature-themed. All artwork must be able to hang in 2D fashion. Sales are made directly to visitors, with 20% of purchase price held back for the Arboretum. Exhibit dates are flexible and March/April was mentioned as a possible option for MAG. Application deadline for the



2025 exhibit year is August 19th. A volunteer is need to coordinate this exhibit (communicate with the Arboretum, oversee registration entries, artwork setup and take down).

The MAG exhibit at the Firefly Coffeehouse in Oregon is up and available for viewing through August. Fourteen artists participated this year. The Firefly has invited MAG to exhibit on an annual basis.

This year's Summer Salon Exhibit at the UW Hospital has received much praise from visitors. So far, 3-4 sales have been made. Following the reception at the Goodman Center, a small committee met to discuss and address any changes to be made going forward. Artwork pick up at the Children's Hospital is Saturday, July 27th, from 9-10:30am.

AFOS is this coming weekend. Good luck to all the artists in the MAG tent!

MAG will participate as a group this year in Paoli Art in the Park. This event will be held August 31st September 1st, 9am – 4pm.

#### **Glass Studio Tour**

This Thursday, July 11th, at 6:30pm, MAG members are invited to tour the glass studio of Steve Feren, 2601 County Rd MM, Oregon. Large groups are welcome and parking is readily available.

#### **Artful Gathering**

MAG member, G.G., has agreed to present an instructional zoom meeting for artists who wish to learn more about social media and websites. G.G. explained that she went from zero social media presence in 2020 to having a current following of 130,000. She is happy to provide advice about branding, driving traffic to websites, monetization of apps, Facebook vs Instagram, and much more. The meeting date and time will be announced soon, but is expected to take place prior to September 20th of this year.

#### **MAG Picnic**

Cindy Koshalek will host this year's Picnic/Potluck at her home in Verona on Wednesday, August 21st, 4-8pm. The event will be held rain or shine. Cindy will provide a tent, as well as cups, utensils, napkins. Her address is 551 Hickory Ct. RSVPs are requested.

### **MAG Art Shows Participation Protocol**

Linda noted that four new art shows have been added during her term as president, which brings our total to seven. She added that participant selection for events which use the MAG tent have been determined based on a MAG policy which was last updated in 2021. According to that policy, names are drawn via a lottery held at the annual dinner in October. Eligibility for the lottery drawing dictates that a member: 1) must have volunteered at least once during the past year, 2) must have a body of work large enough to fill their portion of the tent, 3) must declare their media, 4) must pay their portion of the event fee, 5) must sign an agreement governing art fairs, 6)



must not have been a participant in the MAG tent for at least two years. The event coordinator/chair is exempt from the two-year abstinence rule and may participate yearly, but they must choose participation in only one group event each year regardless of how many they might coordinate.

There was brief discussion as to whether the two-year wait time for lottery eligibility should be shortened, but no changes were made at this time.

### Acknowledgements

Linda congratulated the Summer Salon award winners as well as all who participated in the show. She praised the exhibit as a wonderful and diverse art show.

### **Open Forum**

Barbara Koykkar plans to continue her well-received Art in the Schools project and welcomes suggestions for a theme for the next display. Last year's theme was "daydreams".

Linda announced that she will not run for a second term as president and will step down at the Annual Dinner.

Ken Halfmann made mention that he is available to photograph member's artwork for jurying.

Cindy announced that, after this year's annual dinner at Imperial Gardens, she plans to resign her position as chair. She mentioned that whoever assumes responsibility for the event is welcome to move the dinner location to the venue of their choice.

Linda called for a move to adjourn. Cindy moved to end the meeting and was seconded by Theresa. The meeting was adjourned at 7:18pm. The next meeting will be held via zoom on September 10th. Minutes Submitted by: Colette Girard
